- ***Are you travelling to the Middle East?***

The U.S. State Department posts periodic travel warnings and other information about the potential risks involved in travel to or through areas undergoing unrest. We strongly recommend that you check for updates while planning your trip. Go to <http://travel.state.gov> and read the sections on alerts and warnings.

- ***What kind of visa will you need?***

While many countries permit U.S. citizens to cross their borders without a visa, many do not. It is important to know well in advance what kind of visa you will need, and whether you will also need a letter of invitation, which is often used to justify longer-term business visas.
